KEY PROJECTS AT LOCKHART GARRATT

Wellingborough Golf Club

Management of the tree resource at the golf course. This includes producing planting schemes and managing tree safety. Where and when necessary recommending tree works and appointing tree contractors.

Kelling Estate, Norfolk

Surveying of trees in areas of public access, principally roadside and footpath trees. A tree schedule and report was produced that outlined remedial tree works that were neither too prescriptive nor inadequate to address the landowner's duty of care.

Coronation Park, Corby

Assessment of the tree population from a local park planted in 1953. The survey consisted of assessing each tree on its future contribution in terms of its remaining life expectancy and condition. The findings of the report are to inform the design of the parks future regeneration.

The site is at a design stage with the aim to have the site fully restored as a recreational facility. The tree survey has indicated the principal tree resource (including a TPO woodland) that will aid the design process.
